Grimsby Gang Show so far

It all started in 1956 by the late Mr. Ken Hodson. With the first show being staged at South Parade church hall.

The following years saw the show move to Old Clee School, The Pier Theatre Royal and finally The Ritz, Cleethorpes in 1965, when the show finished.

During the first 10 years The Gang Show gained national recognition. So much so that the BBC Radio made two live broadcasts from The Theatre Royal and The Ritz Cinema, Cleethorpes. I am pleased to say that I was in The Gang for both these broadcasts.

Four years passed without a show but by 1969 the late Norris Alderson and the late Kier Davie together restarted the show. For 11 years continued the high standard we expect from The Gang.

In 1982 Mr. Stuart Creese became the producer assisted by Mr. Neil Garnett and myself. We stayed together until 1987 when Stuart and I continued joined by Dave Stagg. 1987 was also the year when Jean, my wife became wardrobe mistress and has been by my side as Gang Show co-ordinator ever since.

Gang Show grew from strength to strength when in 1989 the club joined the show for the first time, with Margaret Blades as producer assisted by Phil and Pam Alderson.

In 1992 The Gang Show moved from the Memorial Hall to The Ice House, it was then Barry Whitfield with his band Regency joined us for the first time and are still with us today. Also Pat Yarborough agreed to become our choreographer and has been a great asset to the show and is truly one of The Gang.

1993 I became the producer when Mr. Stuart Creese took the role of Gang Show Chairman. Gareth Scarborough joined Dave Stagg as assistant producer.

The Ice House was our regular venue until 1996 when we took a gamble by moving to the then new Grimsby Auditorium and I am pleased to say that thanks to your support, our audiences have grown over the years, which makes it possible to be here today.

1996 saw a change in the Junior Gang producers led by Doug Chadwick assisted by Ian Jones and Maureen Tink. What an asset the juniors are to the show!

1997 I found myself with a need to recruit a new assistant and found Joanne Mitchell and John Armstrong brought their own individual talents to the team. This team continued and in the year 2000 once again The Grimsby Gang Show was awarded National recognition, which means we reached the high standard of production required by the headquarters to continue to wear the coveted red scarf.

Well that about brings the story so far up to date. I am still at the helm with Dave Stagg, new boy Andy Arundel as assistant producer, Jean as show co-ordinator and now joined by my daughter Annabel as production assistant.

A special thanks must go to our musical director for 11 years, Mr. Jonathan Fletcher. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank Mary Alderson, Jean Smith, Albert, Ivy Jones and Norman Watham and many others for their years of service with The Gang.

It only remains to thank you the audience for supporting Grimsby Gang Show over the years. Hope you enjoy the show!

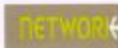

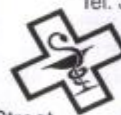

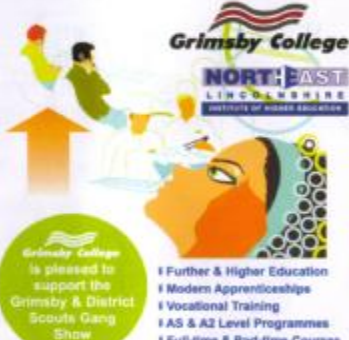
